

Help...The Boilers Have Died!

Our church building relies on three boilers to keep us toasty warm when it is cold outside. All three boilers have reached their life expectancy and two of the three boilers completely died near the end of the heating season. We have had regular maintenance and repairs on the boilers as needed over the years, but now they are in need of being replaced.

The Trustee Team has received contractor bids for replacing the boilers and passed that information on to our Leadership Board. The Board voted to replace the boilers with air handlers that will heat and air condition the entire church building efficiently and effectively.

The cost of this project is approximately \$50,000. We have some contingency funds that are budgeted for capital improvement projects and some funds from one of our church Foundation accounts. But together, we need to offer gifts to complete this project. Yes, last summer it was replacing the church roof and this summer it is replacing the boilers! The good news is we are able to take on this project in the summer and not in the middle of winter when it becomes an emergency situation to not have working boilers.
