Extra Payment toward Mortgage

Sarah made a motion, Christy second and motion carried unanimously to pay an extra \$30,000 on the mortgage using \$5,000 from the principle of the Bashford fund and \$25,000 from our pre-paid capital campaign or where Lisa guides us to take money from.

Roof repair in fellowship hall -Great Lakes Roofing stayed dry last 2 rains.

Server Door Repair and Door Closer—Martin Glass \$2,000 Office Door—NASCO \$3,000

Planned Near Term Work

Drywall in Fellowship Hall Ceiling—\$1,200 total (John doing part of it) Light Fixtures (2 in conference room-Ballast in women's bath room and 2 bug eye lights)—Faith Technologies--\$600.

Floor Waxing--\$3,200

Flooring near pantry—will be paid by benefactor.

Hole Patching--\$1,500

HVAC/Heat Exchanger—replacement and service contract—3 bids for replacement and service contract Range \$ 17,200-18,400 for Heat exchanger and \$6,278/yr. for service contract.

Catch Basin/Sink Hole \$13,000 for new clean out system and \$4,000 for casting
